Why PPC 12.5?

- In march 2020 the Corona pandemic became really strong
- Several members of the IACPA discussed future positron conferences
- Decision: PSD-20 and PPC-13 should be done
- Only online conferences were possible
- PSD-20 was finally successfully organized in March 2021
- Japanese organizers of PPC-13 could not do the online meeting
- It was clear: Organizer must be somehow PC-affine
- I asked Radek to do PPC again (PPC-12 was in Lublin)
- He agreed without discussion ;-)
- Now is clear: PPC-13 will be organized by Yasuyuki Nagashima in 2024
- Thus: Radek decided to call the online-PPC: PPC-12.5
